



PREVENT WATER FROM POOLING ON THE FIELD BEFORE IT RAINS

MATS



COVERS PROBLEM AREAS:

- Bases, Pitchers mound, Home plate & Batters box
- Prevents mud build up
- Reusable

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Place 4- 6' X 6' mats rubber side up over bases and pitchers mound
- Place 1- 6' X 8' mat rubber side up over home plate & batters box
 - This allows water to collect on top for easy draining
 - Absorbent side down will draw moisture in, leaving a drier area
- Stake down corners with included stakes to prevent them from blowing away. At game time, remove stakes and remove water doing one of the following:
 - Lift 2 Adjacent sides of mat and drain water to one side of field
 - Lift all 4 corners together and walk mat to another area to drain
 - Place Sport Saver pillows & socks on top to quickly absorb water, remove & dispose
- Continue until all mats have been removed from field
- Mats are reusable and should be stored in dry area
- To avoid mold & mildew, allow mats to dry prior to storage

REMOVE POOLED WATER ON FIELD, AFTER IT RAINS

BAGS



BAGS & TUBES

- Quickly removes standing water
- Compact, portable & disposable

BAGS COVER:

Bases, Pitchers mound, Home plate, Batters box & more

TUBES COVER:

Dugout Benches, Sliding areas & other problem areas

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Lay bags and tubes in standing water
- Allow water to be absorbed
- Bags and tubes will swell when in contact with water
- If water is still present after bags and tubes are filled, replace with another one
- Dispose of bags and tubes in trash
